Taushia adopted her nephew who has been growing quickly and enjoying quality time with new friends on the playground.

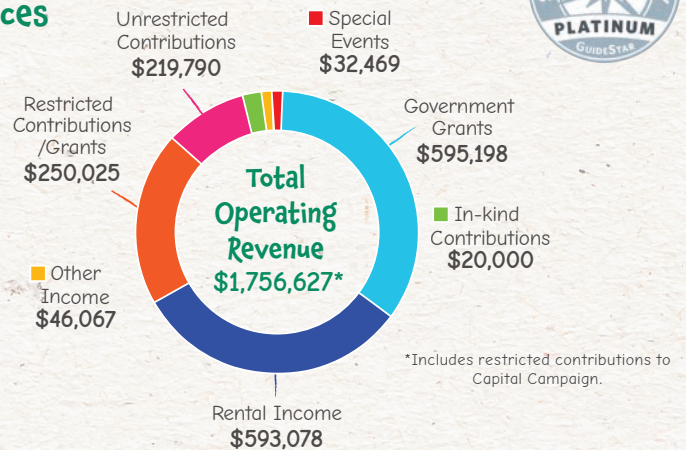
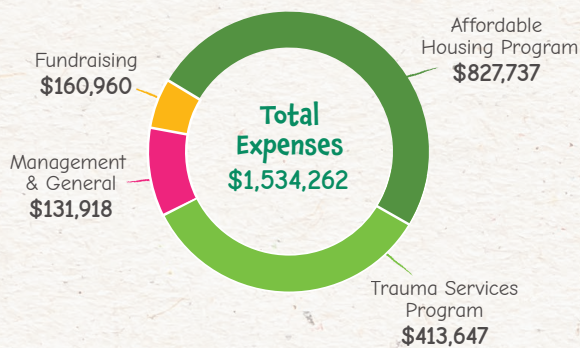


Patreaka

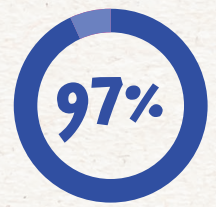

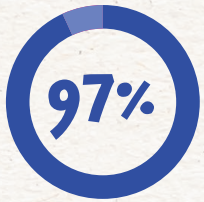

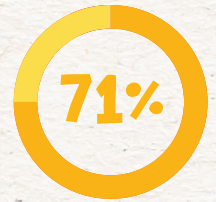
